- 6.2 LS provided an overview of the biggest challenges facing electricity distribution networks, how current or proposed plans are addressing these challenges, and the potential roles for both network and non-network solutions such as flexibility in meeting the demands of a net zero system.
- 6.3 NS provided an overview of the biggest challenges in customers connecting to the distribution network and to what extent policy is addressing these challenges, and how the process of working with DNOs to connect to the network could improve.
- 6.4 Commissioners and panel members discussed the challenges.
